



## Spellzone

If pupils have a standardised score of 85 or less for spelling, they will be using a site called Spellzone. The course is used to teach and improve English spelling within school. Spellzone is suitable for helping students with dyslexia. It is also used to help teach English worldwide. The great benefit with this site is that pupils can also use it at home to practise units of work, play the games and generally revise their spelling skills. They can also use it in the library during break, lunchtime, or after school or in Learning Support during lunchtime homework club. Staff from Learning Support will monitor progress regularly, including the sessions completed at home, and in this way we can give the best advice on when to move on to the next unit or areas that need further work. By attending all sessions in school and practicing at home, we are confident pupils could achieve a standardised score of 90+.
