



Learning Support Facilities

The department has an excellent suite of rooms which provide space for both small group teaching and individual tutorials

Learning Support 1

This is our main teaching room, a light and airy space, which provides facility to teach groups of up to 10 pupils. The room is also equipped with a suite of computers. This room is used at lunchtime for homework club. There is an extensive range of supportive textbooks, revision guides and educational games.

Learning Support 2



Originally designed for the use of a student using a wheelchair this is now an additional teaching room again capable of holding small groups. There is a fully equipped accessible toilet and food preparation area. This room is used as a “haven” at break time and lunchtime by students who do not yet feel confident to attend lunch in the main hall.

Tutorial Rooms 1 and 2



These rooms are used by smaller groups and for individual tutorials. One is primarily used for numeracy teaching whilst the other is used for literacy.

Room 10 – Nurture Group and Transition

Both Nurture and Transition groups are held in a well-resourced room, specifically developed to meet both Nurture and educational needs. A well equipped kitchen area gives opportunities to develop life skills; ICT facilities, including learning via interactive technology, allow pupils to access a very wide range of learning tools and an informal seating area provides a relaxed environment for developing reading skills.



Corridor Area

This very quiet area has desks overlooking a garden and provides further study facilities for individual pupils.



Outside areas (Sculpture Garden)

There is easy access to an outside seating area with benches and tables and a pleasant grassed area.
